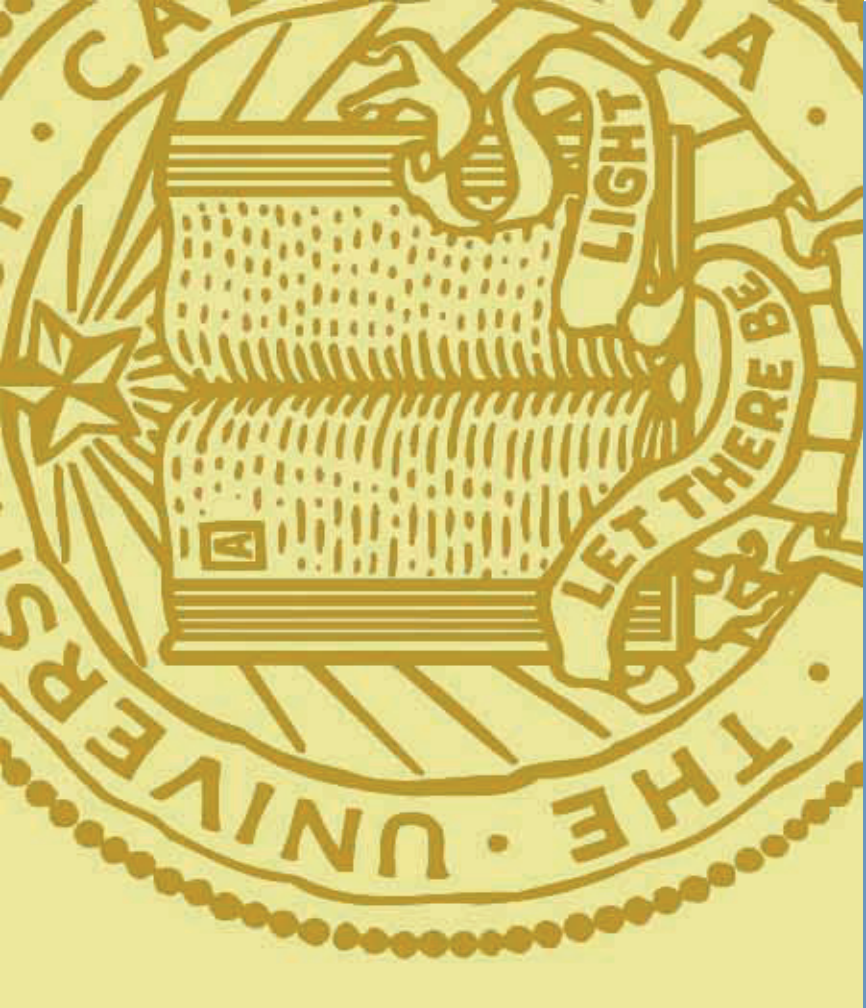
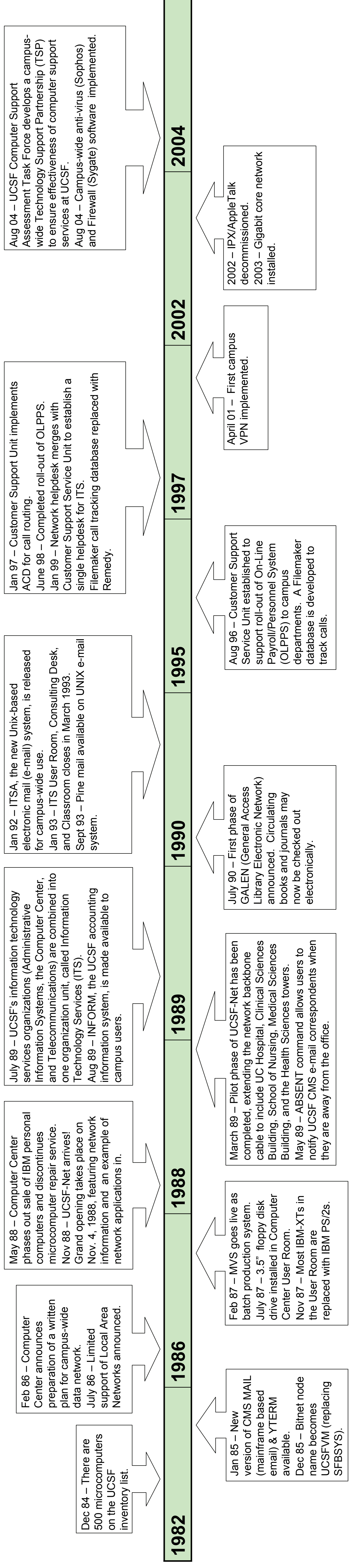

SATE Program

May 2006 – Enterprise Information Security (EIS) launches the Security Awareness, Training and Education (SATE) program. This program promotes security awareness through education activities that include brown-bag discussions, training sessions, posters, information sheets, and newsletters.



May 2006 – Convergence of interests and needs within Academic and Administrative Information Technology results in the formation of a new, collaborative organization: Office of Academic and Administrative Information Systems (OAAIS – "oasis")

June 2006 – OAAIS discontinues ITSA, a 14 year old Unix-based e-mail system, and converts users to mail@UCSF, an Exchange e-mail system.

SPAM Filtering

September 2006 – OAAIS installs a spam firewall solution for mail@UCSF. The new spam firewall allows each customer to set up a personal email quarantine mailbox with individualized rules and filters to allow for increased spam protection and control.

August 2006 – OAAIS releases a new "clientless" SSL VPN system for use by UCSF faculty, staff, and students.

April 2007 – Student Academic Affairs (SAA) implements Resource 25, an online classroom scheduling system for general assignment space.
